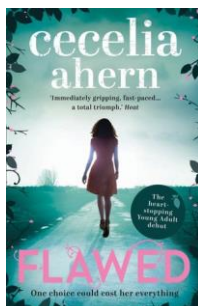




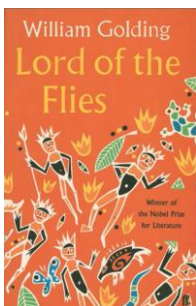
Recommended Reading List - Teenage

Unable to communicate or move, she relies on her family for everything. She has a sharp brain and knows all sorts of things about everyone but when she is confronted with this secret, she is utterly powerless to do anything. Though that might be about to change....



Celestine North lives a perfect life. She's a model daughter and sister and she's dating the impossibly charming Art Creva. But then Celestine breaks a rule and now faces life-changing repercussions. She could be imprisoned. She could be branded. She could be found *flawed*. In a society where perfection is paramount and flaws lead to punishment, one young woman decides to take a stand that could cost her everything.



When a plane crashes on a desert island, the only survivors are a group of schoolboys. By day they inhabit a land of fantastic birds and blue seas, but at night their dreams are haunted by the image of a terrifying beast. 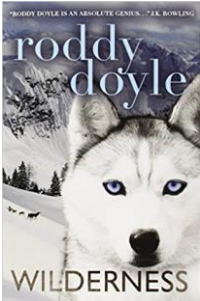

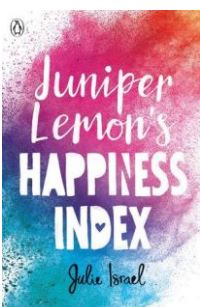

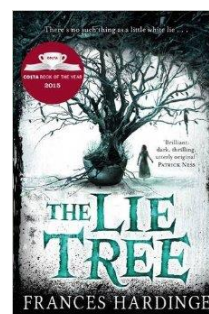
Set during the second world war, this is the story of Liesel Meminger, a foster girl living outside Munich. Liesel tries to eke out a meager existence for herself by stealing. Then she encounters something she can't resist - books. With the help of her kind, accordion-playing foster father, she learns to read. She shares her stolen books with her neighbors during bombing raids, as well as with the Jewish man hidden in her basement before he is marched to the concentration camp in Dachau. The story is narrated by Death and when Death tells a story, you really have to listen.



Things are going wrong for Philip Wright: detentions, broken specs, a teacher who thinks he's a poet and a mother who's started acting weird. Philip's happy-go-lucky life is disrupted when his mother is diagnosed with breast cancer. As Philip tries to cope, he writes letters to his hero, the comedian Harry Hill, looking for advice. But also in his life there's The Yeti, The Goddess, The Meerkats and Philip's best friend Ang. The story is a touching and funny take on life, love and cancer.



It's been sixty-five days since the accident that killed Juniper's sister and ripped Juniper's world apart. Then she discovers the letter written by Camilla on the day of the accident, addressed mysteriously to 'You', but never sent. Desperate to identify Camilla's secret love and deliver the message, Juniper starts to investigate. Until she loses something. A card from the Happiness Index: little notecards on which she rates the day. The Index has been holding Juniper together since Camilla's death - but a lost card only widens the hole she left behind. And this particular card contains Juniper's own secret: a memory she can't let anyone else find out.



Faith has a thirst for science and secrets that the rigid confines of her class cannot suppress. When Faith's disgraced father is found dead under mysterious circumstances, she is determined to untangle the truth from the lie. But as Faith's untruths spiral out of control, she discovers that where lies seduce, truths shatter.....
