Students Leaving School: It is school policy that students are not allowed to leave the school without being collected by a parent/guardian or a designated adult made known to the school. This applies to all students regardless of the year they are in. Students must have a sign out pass signed by the Year Head. 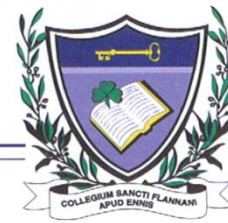
