

Transition into St. Flannan's College Highlights from First Year Student Survey 2020

In October/November 2020, First Year students were surveyed to evaluate the ease of their transition from Primary school into St Flannan's College.

189 students out of a cohort of 216 students completed the online survey (87.5% return rate).

The main findings are as follows:

- 63% of the surveyed students had read the newly designed "First Years Information Booklet".
- 69% felt nervous on their first day of school, but only 22% still did at the end of Induction.
- While only 52% felt confident on their first day, the proportion had increased to 78% at the end of Induction.
- By level of importance, students identified their Class Teachers, their Class Tutor and the Induction Programme as helping them settle in the school.
- 87% consider they are doing well in school.
- 95% have made new friends since joining St. Flannan's.
- 97% say they are proud to be St. Flannan's College students.
