Summer Exam Results:

1st, 2nd, T.Y. and 5th Year results will be available through ASSESSMENTS on the VSware app after 17th June 2023. 2nd Yr students may have a CBA1 descriptor included for some subjects.

Student not returning:

If your son/daughter is not returning to St. Flannan's College, please inform the school in writing or by e-mail as soon as possible.

VSware:

VSware is the system that our school is using to record exam results & attendance. Ensure you have the latest version of the VSware App downloaded on your phone to ensure you can log student absences. Please click on the following link to find details on how to install and set up the App.

Visitors:

All visitors must report to reception upon entering the school and sign the visitors' book. In relation to dropping off items for students a box marked "student collection" is available outside the office door. Parents/guardians can make arrangement with their child to collect items from there. The school accepts no responsibility for items left for collection.

Contact Details:

It is important that the school has up to date contact details for every student. Please inform us of any changes of address or telephone number particularly mobile phone numbers as this is critical in the event of an emergency or illness. Updated details should be sent by e-mail to

School Uniform:

The School Uniform is a compulsory requirement of St. Flannan's College. Students must be in full school uniform and note that white runners/converse shoes are not permitted, neither are grey jeans, tracksuit pants or leggings. The school uniform is available from Pyne's Abbey Street or McCannon's Market Street, Ennis. The Department of Social Welfare supports families who may need assistance through the Back-to-School Clothing and Footwear scheme. Applications are open from June to September and families should contact the Department of Social Welfare directly or apply on mywelfare.ie. Students are expected to present in a well-groomed manner taking due care that their uniform is well maintained. Hoodies are not permitted and may be confiscated if worn in school. Offensive logos or language on clothing is not permitted. Body piercings are not allowed except for earrings (which should be either small studs or sleepers). Facial piercings are not permitted.



School Diary:

A school homework diary is compulsory for all students and will be distributed to students on the first day of term. It is an important way of tracking homework and parents should check the homework diary daily. The cost of the diary is included in the Insurance/Administration contribution.

Insurance/Administration Contribution:

The contribution is eighty euro per student. Parents/Guardians experiencing financial difficulty should contact the school directly. Parents/Guardians can contribute through the Way2Pay link which is located on the top school website home page – www.stflannanscollege.ie

Lockers:

Lockers will be allocated to student's who have reserved them. We recommend a lock size of 35mm. We do not recommend combination locks.

Fifth Year Subject Choice:

While every effort is made to facilitate student subject choices in Fifth Year, changes to staffing allocation may impact on what the school can reasonably provide. We will allow for a certain amount of flexibility in changing subject choices but again constraints outside of our control may impact upon that flexibility. Fifth year book list is enclosed, **however parents & students are advised not to purchase books until subjects and levels are finalised in September.**

Mobile Phones:

Mobile phones should not be used during class without the permission of the class teacher or between classes as this leads to serious disruption of the teaching and learning environment. Please refer to our mobile device policy on the school web site. Students are not permitted to take photographs of other students or staff, record other students or staff or upload students/staff/school activities onto social network sites. There are serious disciplinary consequences should this happen.

Smoking/Vaping:

State legislation requires that the school is maintained as a smoke free zone which includes school grounds and facilities. Students found smoking or vaping will incur an automatic two-day suspension. Please note e-cigarettes are included in this policy.

Attendance:

Regular and punctual attendance for the full school day is vitally important for effective learning and social integration. Students who are late for school and class tend to disrupt the teaching and learning environment for other students. Parents of students who are late must submit the late/absence on the VSware App and students must sign the late book in the school office otherwise they will be recorded as absent.



Leaving School for an appointment:

In the case of a student having to leave school to attend appointments during the school day:

- parents/guardians must in advance submit the absence on the Vs Ware App before 9am.
- The year head will then approve/reject the absence request.
- Parents/Guardians must sign out their child in the sign out book when they collect them from the office. There is no requirement to come in with the student upon their return to school. Students must be collected in school by a parent/guardian or person nominated by the parent/guardian. If a person other than a parent/guardian is collecting a student, this should be noted on Vs Ware.
- For students who are over 18 years of age, parents must submit an absence request on VSware and students must sign out in the office. Parents/Guardians are not required to sign out students who are over 18 years of age.

Leaving School due to illness:

In the event of a student becoming ill during the school day, school personnel will contact the Parent/Guardian and arrange for the student to be collected from school. Students cannot leave the school without meeting with their year head or deputy principal for the absence to be recorded. Students must be collected by a parent/guardian or person nominated by the parent/guardian. If a person other than a parent/guardian is collecting a student, this should be noted on Vs Ware.

Student Photography:

Photographs of student participation in school events may be published in school materials such as the prospectus, the school newsletter, school website, official social media accounts or local papers. If you do not wish for such photographs of your child to be published, please inform the school in writing or by email.

Medication:

Parents/Guardians who arrange to have any type of medication held in the school for their child we wish to clarify that it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian and not the school to ensure that the medication and instructions are always in date. For students over eighteen who are responsible for their own medication and wish to have medication held in the school the same responsibility applies.

Dropping off/Collecting - Traffic on School Grounds:

We request that parents do not drive onto the school grounds when dropping off students and instead drop students on the several approach routes to the school. Please, co-operate with us by not driving onto the school grounds to drop off or collect your child. Parents/Guardians of students with mobility and or special needs please contact the school office to make arrangements with the Principal in this matter. We look forward to seeing you in September and hope you all have a happy and enjoyable summer.
