In October 2024, St. Flannan's College, along with CBS Primary School, Barefield National School and Rice College became part of a Consortium which aim was to implement project activities and facilitate the mobility of learners and staff to Ennis's twin town of Langenfeld, Germany.


This initiative strives to foster cultural awareness, enhance digital competencies, and promote the study of the German language within all four schools. The Consortium was subsequently awarded Erasmus+ Accreditation for the current academic year as well as the next one.

In early October 2025, three German teachers from St. Flannan's College, along with teachers from the other three Consortium schools, travelled to Langenfeld for a week-long mobility focused on collaboration, observation and partnership building.


Throughout the week, they engaged with German teachers, visited schools, and explored educational, cultural and environmental practices. The experience strongly aligned with the core objectives of our Erasmus+ project and has directly informed how we plan to support our students during our upcoming educational trips to Germany.

During this visit, SFC established a partnership with a local post-primary school, Bettine-von-Arnim-Gesamtschule. Since then, teachers in both schools have been cooperating in developing activities which implement our core objectives.

## **APRIL 2026 EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO LANGENFELD**

As part of our Erasmus+ project, we will bring a group of thirty Second Year students studying German to Langenfeld between the 19th and the 24th of April 2026. This educational trip will be partly funded by Erasmus+ funds. The students will be accompanied by members of St. Flannan's College teaching staff and will be visiting Langenfeld and the wider area of Cologne and Düsseldorf. They will also visit their partner school and complete several activities with the German students.

Both schools are working on a project entitled '*A day in our lives*'. St. Flannan's and Beate-von-Arnim-Gesamtschule students will explore similarities and differences in their respective lives by exploiting authentic material and using technology, thus developing global awareness, as per the core objectives of the project, as explained further down.

## **FUTURE ACTIVITIES**

A second trip will be organised in November 2026 for the remaining Second Year students who are not going to Germany in April.
